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LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

AMIGA

1. Turn off the computer and disconnect all unnecessary peripherals. We recommend that you leave your computer turned off for 30 seconds in case a virus has installed itself into the computer's memory.
2. Insert the boot disk into the drive and switch the computer on. The game will now begin to load. Do not remove the disc from the drive whilst the game is playing.

PC

1. Insert floppy into Drive A or B and Type Brutal to run from floppy.
2. To install onto Hard Disk - as above, from floppy drive type install C: and follow the on-screen instructions.
3. The game can be played with joystick or keyboard, all the keys can be user defined. Follow the on-screen instructions to define your keys. Choices in the frontend can be made using the cursor keys, return and space.

NOTE: If you are using a Joystick - to use the power-ups, do a short press on Fire 2 and a long press to scroll through them. Requires minimum 590k base memory and 1Mb of Extended Memory (EMS). If you do not have enough free memory please refer to your DOS manual for instructions on how to enable EMS and how to make a system disk.



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Welcome to Brutal Football. To guide you through this knuckle-dusting, face-crunching game are Jim Skinner and Bob Tanner, the most famous managers in the history of the sport.

"Hi folks, Jim Skinner here. There are two types of Brutal Football players, those who want a piece of 'in your face action' straightaway and those who want to find out about leagues and knockouts and the like. Well, if you're one of the first types, press down and fire on joystick, then Fire six times. Faster than you can say "Hack off his head", you're in your first unfriendly match. ENJOY!"



If you can't stand the heat and want to get detailed information on different competitions and rules - I hate that word - see the section later on. Now for some body-slamming, double decapitating moves, here's my old mate, Bob Tanner."

"Thanks, Jim Bob me old pal. So you're in your first game and your players are getting kebabed or atomised. You need to know the basic moves in BRUTAL FOOTBALL."

- A player will automatically pick up the ball when he runs over it.
- Once in possession, press fire to pass ball.
- Press and hold down fire to kick the ball in the direction a player is facing.
- When not in possession, press fire to punch an opponent or launch a flying tackle.
- Stand over an opponent and press fire to stomp him.
- Press and hold fire to make a flying catch.

Now you think you're ready to rumble. Well, you're going to end up kissing dirt unless you take in the finer points of the game. This game ain't just about kicking and punching. It takes a lot of skill and practice to learn the best way of mincing the opposition. Here's how. Objects or icons will appear on the pitch at various times during a game.

Now you know what's available, you'll want to know how to put it all into action. Back to Mr Skinner himself. Yo, give me a high five and a low dive. Here's how to turn yourself into the best Brutal Football player since the Red Devils of Blood Alley.

Run over an icon to pick it up. A maximum of three icons can be held at any one time. See State of Play below.

Player one hold down the F1, player two F10 button down to scroll through stored icons. (Amiga 500/600/1200)
Player one press F2 and Player two F9 to unleash your weapons on opponents.

STATE OF PLAY

So you want to see if you're getting a mauling or if you're pasting the opposition? Sure you can. If you want any information about the game it's all there in the state of play panel.



- The dots on the central panel shows the position of every player on the pitch.
- The flashing coloured dots are the selected players.
- The white flashing dots show position of power ups.
- The solid white dot is the ball.
- Top bar shows the strength of your selected player.
- Lower bar shows overall team strength.
- Window shows any icons held by team.
- Hold down F1/F10 to scroll through your icons (Amiga only).
- Clock shows game time remaining.
- The score is shown in these boxes.

THE RULES

I guess the good people at home have had enough of us by now, you're probably itching to get into some blood-letting, so we'll let you go.

Hold on Jim. I think you're forgetting the different competitions and their rules.

Pa, I hate that word. OK, OK, here goes.

- You can win a Brutal Football Game by outscoring the opposition OR by slaughtering six out of their seven players.
- Each game lasts seven minutes.
- Once the game begins - there are no rules.
- If a game ends in a draw, the ball is thrown away and injury time is played. During this time each team must fight to the death. The first person to kill six opponents wins.

Ha! Injury time. That's more like it. Now can they get on with it? I'm dying to see some fast and furious action.

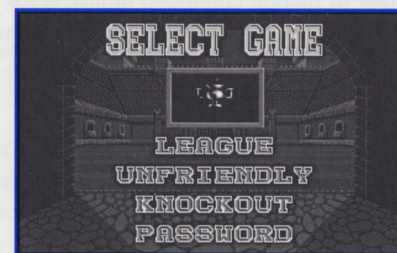
Sorry Bob we need to explain the different games that can be played. Let's start with the unfriendly.

How about we start with being unfriendly?.... SMACK ... I'm afraid Jim is having a quick lie down ... STOMP... So I'll begin.



UNFRIENDLIES

After starting the game, the select game screen will appear. Scroll through the choices using the joystick and chose UNFRIENDLY by pressing fire.



- Unfriendlies can be played by 1 or 2 players.
- Scroll through the eight humanoid teams
- Press fire to select a team.
- Type in the new name if you wish to customise team names.
- Use keyboard to change letters.
- Moving it left or right will select whichever letter you wish to change.
- Press fire again to get control options.
- Use joystick to scroll though control options.
- Each option is explained on screen.
- Press fire again to select preferred control option.
- Both players must chose teams (two player mode only).

NUMBER OF GAMES

After selecting team and control option, the player can choose how many unfriendlies they wish to play. There is a choice of playing one game, best of three or best of seven. Scroll through these options and press Fire to select.

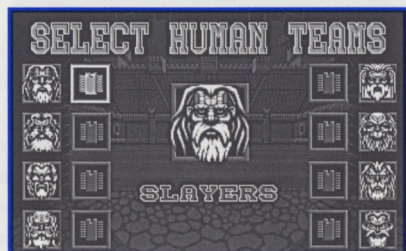
That's about all there is to know about unfriendlies. My old sparring partner Ed Case seems to be recovering in time to explain the knockout competition. Let me give you a hand OOF!

Hello folks, it seems that Jim's been knocked-out by the knockout competition. But he will insist on getting up like the old battler he is CRUNCH.

THE KNOCK-OUTS

Eight Viking teams compete in the knock-out competition. Scroll through the teams on screen and press fire to select your team.

To select computer or human controlled teams, scroll through the column with computer chip or hand icons and press fire. Change of name is possible by typing in new name.



If you win a game you will proceed to the semi-finals. Your next opponents will be selected by the computer.

THE LEAGUE

OK, OK. Let's crank it up for the big one - the Brutal Football League.

Dust down those knuckle dusters and get ready to slash and smash. But first, here's some information supplied by Noel 'Bonecruncher' Knowall, our resident expert on all aspects of the league. OK then, shoot ... on no. I didn't mean ... stop BANG!

The idea for a Brutal Football League was first mooted in 2034 when the American Football Leagues dwindled due to audience boredom. Brutal Football was invented by a Mr Dan Syco and was initially conceived as a crude population control operation.

At first Brutal Football matches, played by humans were extremely popular. However, interest began to die as quickly as the players. Crowds grew restless as the games rarely lasted for more than a minute. Two teams dominated this period: the Braindead Bazooka's and the high-flying National Nukers.

The final confrontation between these teams drew an enormous crowd to the Badlands Arena where the game was to be fought. An explosive match was predicted. Unfortunately, no one had predicted quite how explosive it would be. Within thirty seconds the Nukers lived up to their name as they declared war on their opponents - thermo-nuclear war. The entire land mass of Utopia was obliterated. The result was deemed a no score draw.

This setback might have seen the end of the game but for Professor Graham Geek. His genetically engineered bi-peds proved ideal players of the game. Once production had been taken over by Acme Bi-Peds Inc, the league was up and running.

After long and detailed consideration - lasting at least three minutes - the following rules were made up.

- Four leagues exist.
- Each new member of the league must start at the bottom of the fourth division with a team of Viking Bi-peds and attempt to work through the league.
- Each league is made up of four teams.
- Six games must be played per season.
- Three points are awarded for an outright win
- Two points are awarded for winning after injury time.
- One point is awarded for losing after injury time.

That's great Noel. I love this game! And seeing Ed Case on the floor there in a pool of blood reminds me of the special locker room option that occurs at the end of each match. To explain how this works, let's hear a big hand for Doc. Harry Skulls.

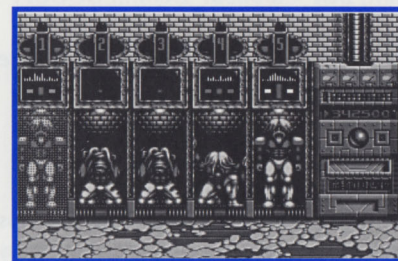
Gee thanks Bill. Hey, you're looking a bit overworked, you need to take a break, a neck break. CRUNCH. Enjoy your lie down - you'll thank me later.



At the end of each league game a championship screen appears. Scroll through the options and press fire to select your choice. The screen appearing at the end of each league match has two extra choices. The first is the locker room option.

THE LOCKER ROOM

When entering the locker room you will see your players in various states of repair. You can try and return your players to match fitness and select players for your next match.



You can select players from the nine bi-ped squad. Player number one is a specialist goalkeeper. All others will play in any position.

The physical health of players is constantly checked and displayed on monitors above their heads.

Select the player you will treat by scrolling through team then pressing fire when reaching appropriate player.

A door will then appear in front of this player. Three sorts of treatment are available, each with their own sign.

- Too cure flesh wounds.
- The 'magic sponge' will clear up serious injuries.
- Cranial reconstruction is reserved for the most serious cases.

BE WARNED all treatment costs money. The health of your medical finances is monitored on the central panel.

REMEMBER success on the field of battle, er sport, will bring financial rewards.

Having treated your players, you must select your team for the next match.

For automatic team selection, press return, this will choose the first 7 Vikings with heads.

For individual player selection, scroll through your team and press space.

That's all from me folks. Jim and Bob want a few more words with you but seeing as they're temporarily incapacitated, I'll hand you over to the large, capable hands of our very own half man, half mutant, Ben 'Cannibal' Deth.... OOOOF!

Magic stuff, Doc. Now stitch that! Evening all. I've seen a lot of brutal sports and I know the teams. Here they are.

THE VIKINGS



The weakest teams in the league

- Best Viking Player:** Thor Gutstreich Lasse Rate
Best Viking Team: The Blooded Horns - placed sixth in league in 2045
Worst Viking Player: Noggin 'no brain' Nunsense. Debut lasted 1.5 seconds
Special moves: Stomping

THE LIZARDS



The second worst teams in the league are lizard players

- Best Lizard Player:** The Barbecue Beast - a ferocious monster of a player
Best Lizard Team: The Komodo Goat Slayers - fourth placed team in 2048

Special moves: Fire-breathing skills can roast an opponent within seconds

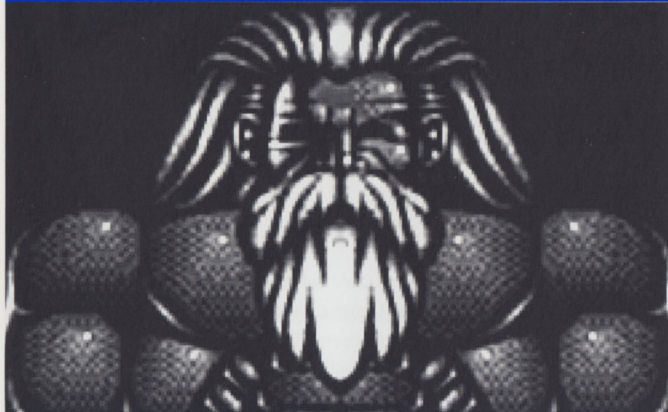
