Important Health Warning About Playing Video Games

Photosensitive Seizures

A very small percentage of people may experience a seizure when exposed to certain visual images, including flashing lights or patterns that may appear in video games. Even people who have no history of seizures or epilepsy may have an undiagnosed condition that can cause these “photosensitive epileptic seizures” while watching video games.

These seizures may have a variety of symptoms, including lightheadedness, altered vision, eye or face twitching, jerking or shaking of arms or legs, disorientation, confusion, or momentary loss of awareness. Seizures may also cause loss of consciousness or convulsions that can lead to injury from falling down or striking nearby objects.

Immediately stop playing and consult a doctor if you experience any of these symptoms. Parents should watch for or ask their children about the above symptoms—children and teenagers are more likely than adults to experience these seizures. The risk of photosensitive epileptic seizures may be reduced by taking the following precautions:

- Sit farther from the television screen.
- Use a smaller television screen.
- Play in a well-lit room.
- Do not play when you are drowsy or fatigued.

If you or any of your relatives have a history of seizures or epilepsy, consult a doctor before playing

THE STORY SO FAR

Remy, a French rat with an acute sense of smell and taste, as well as an uncharacteristic appreciation for fine cuisine, is tired of the same old garbage. Different from the rest of the pack, he dreams of becoming a great chef like his idol, the late Auguste Gusteau, whose cookbook "Anyone Can Cook" has been Remy's only lifeline to the fine culinary world. However, since a rat's daily life is composed mostly of stealing trash for food and avoiding humans who invariably want to kill him, he doesn't have a rat's chance of achieving his impossible dream.

Driven by his passion for cooking, Remy's ambitions to become a chef move one step closer to reality when he accidentally uproots his family from the French countryside. Separated from the others in a frenzied departure, he washes up in the sewers under the streets of Paris, where fortune drops him beneath the namesake restaurant of his culinary hero, Gusteau.

After watching Linguini, the restaurant's hapless garbage boy, unsuccessfully attempt to remake a spoiled pot of soup, Remy furtively fixes the soup himself. When the dish is a hit, Linguini implores the little rat to help him cook it again. The two begin a peculiar but wildly successful cooking relationship, and Remy's culinary genius is finally given a chance to shine.

Remy finds himself torn between his life's passion for cooking and returning forever to his banal existence as a rat. He learns the truth about friendship, family and having no choice but to be who he really is, a rat who wants to be a chef. In the words of his idol Gusteau: "Anyone can cook. But to be great... you must be fearless!"

THE GAME SCREEN



1. HEALTH METER: The Health Meter shows your current health. If your health gets low there are health pick ups throughout the game that will replenish it. Complete chases to get an additional health container and increase Remy's maximum health.

2. COMPASS: An indicator to show you where the next item you need, or task to complete, is located.

SPECIAL MOVES

DOUBLE JUMPS

Press the **A** button twice to perform a double jump.

TIGHT ROPE WALK

Jump and press the **B** button to balance while on a tight rope. Use the **LS** stick to adjust your balance.

POINT JUMPS

Jump and press the **B** button when landing on a point jump to land safely on it. Use the **LS** stick to adjust your balance.

PICK UP

Remy can pick items up. Press the **B** button near certain objects to pick them up.

WALL CLIMB

To climb a wall surface, jump and press the **B** button to grab hold of the wall.

DASH

Remy can Dash for a short amount of time before he needs a rest. Press and hold the **Y** button while moving to Dash. This comes in handy when getting away from enemies.

GUSTEAU HINTS

Press the **RB** bumper to activate hints when they pop up.

SCENT VISION

Helps Remy find his way. To activate Scent Vision press and hold the **LB** bumper.

TAIL SWIPE

Press the **X** button to perform a Tail Swipe.



ITEMS



ATTRACTOR

The Attractor lures insects towards you.



REPELLER

This powerful spray helps you repel the Ant Army, Moths, or the Stink Squad.



CHARMS

Every level has a fixed amount of hidden Charms. If you collect enough of them, you could unlock something special.



CHILI PEPPERS

This veggie packs quite a punch. Activate it with a Tail Swipe and see if you can use it to clear whatever's blocking your path.



DESTRUCTIBLE BOX

This box can only be destroyed with one of the powerful Chili Peppers.



DESTRUCTIBLE CAN

Destroy this can with a Tail Swipe or Chili Pepper.



DESTRUCTIBLE JAR

This jar can only be destroyed with one of the powerful Chili Peppers.



UMBRELLA

Use this item to glide Remy to places that he normally wouldn't be able to reach, or to safely get to lower areas in the world. You need to glide over gusts to reach higher places.



HALF HEALTH PICKUP

Pick one of these up to restore half of your health.



FULL HEALTH PICKUP

These health pickups restore all of your health. They can really come in handy.



HEALTH CONTAINER

Health containers allow you to have one more space for additional health.



HIDEY HOLE

Every once in a while, Remy needs to get away from it all. Find a Hidey Hole when the humans are after you.



HEIST MARKER

Move to one of these locations to activate a Heist Activity.



MINI-GAME MARKER

Move to one of these to activate a mini-game.



MISSION MARKER

Move to one of these to activate a mission.



TIMED CHALLENGE

Move to one of these markers to activate a timed challenge.

OPTIONS
