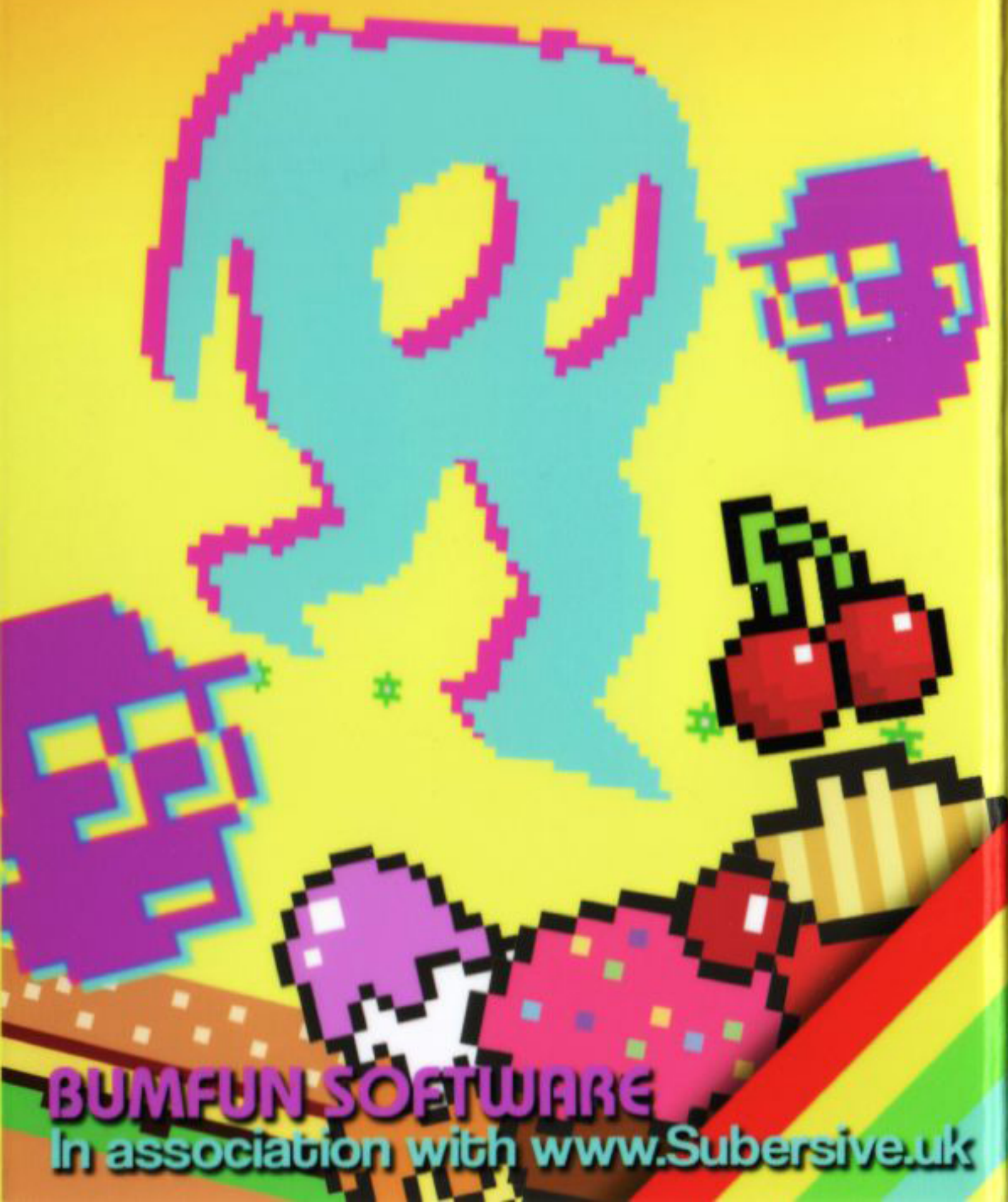


Hungry Horace
